Pilgrimage | Church Groups

- A slow paced biblical tour, covering Jordan, Israel and Egypt.
- Accommodation plan: 2N Amman, 2N Galilee, 4N Bethlehem, 1N Taba, 2N Cairo.
- Tour of Mt Nebo, Madaba and Mekawer in Jordan with accommodation in Amman. [2 nights]
- Entering Israel from the Jordan river border crossing, the tour traverses all major biblical sites in the Galilee. [2 nights]
- Onto Haifa and down the Mediterranean coast to Emmaus, culminating in Bethlehem. [4 nights]
- The tour then centers around Jerusalem visiting all major biblical sites in Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Jericho & Dead Sea.
- The Egypt leg of the comprises of 3 nights with 1 night in Sinai by the Red Sea and 2 nights in Cairo. [3 nights]
- The final part of the tour visits St Catherine, Old Cairo and the Giza Plateau.

Accommodation: Amman

- Transfer to Mt Nebo. (45 Minutes)
- Tour of the memorial of Moses.
- Transfer to Mekawer. (35 minutes)
- Tour of Mekawer - site of the beheading of John the Baptist

- Transfer to Madaba.
- Lunch. [Traditional open buffet]
- Madaba St George Church - mosaic of Jerusalem.
- Transfer to hotel in Amman. (1 hour)

- 07.30 AM - Transfer to Jordan river border crossing.[Sheikh Hussein Bridge].(2 hours)
- 10.30 Enter Israel from Jordan through the Jordan river border crossing (Sheikh Hussein Bridge).
- Transfer to Nazareth. (1 hour 45 minutes)
- Nazareth - Church of the Annunciation & Josef's workshop.
- Tour of Nazareth Village. (optional)
- Transfer to Cana. (30 minutes)
- Lunch. [Festive traditional/Buffer]
- Cana - Church of the wedding miracle.

- Transfer to hotel in Tiberias. (30 minutes)

Day 04 — Mt Tabor, Galilee Churches, St Peters Fish lunch, Galilee Boat Ride & Magdala

Accommodation: Tiberias

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Transfer to Mt Tabor base station. (30 minutes)
- Drive up the Tabor hill in a mini van to visit the Basilica of Transfiguration.
- Transfer to Mt Beatitudes. (30 minutes)
- Mt Beatitudes - site of Jesus's sermon on the mount.
- Kfar Nahum or Capernaum, the city of Jesus and the site of Jesus's ministry.
- Tabga - site of the multiplication miracle.
- Peter's House & Mensa Christy.
- Lunch. [St Peter's Fish lunch]
- Boat Ride in the Sea of Galilee on a replica of ancient Galilean boats.
- Tour of the recently excavated site of Magdala, the first century city of Mary Magdalene.

Day 05 — Haifa, Muharakha, Emmaus & Bethlehem

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- 07.00 Transfer to Haifa. (1 hour)
- Mt Carmel. Visit Elijah's Cave at the Stella Marris chapel.
- View of Bahai Gardens and Temple.
- 09.00 Transfer to Dalyat el Carmel. (45 minutes)
- Visit the Carmelite sanctuary of Muharakha. View of the Jezreel valley.
- 10.00 Transfer to Emmaus Nicopolis[Sundays closed]. (1 hour, 45 minutes)
- Visit the ancient ruins believed to be the biblical site of Emmaus.
- Transfer to Bethlehem. (1 Hours)
- Lunch. (Traditional Palestinian BBQ)
- Shepherd's Field.
- Shopping for Religious Articles.
- Nativity Church & the grotto of Nativity.
- Transfer to Hotel.

Day 06 — Mt Olives, Gethsemane, Old city of Jerusalem & Western Wall

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Transfer to Jerusalem. (1 hour, requires check point crossing)
- Tour of Mt Olives. View the iconic Dome of the Rock from Mt Olives.
- Short visit to the chapel of Ascension.
- Tour the sanctuary of Pater Noster where The Lord's Prayer is embedded in the walls in numerous languages.
- Palm Sunday Road - view from below only, the steep decent being perilous.
- Visit the Basilica at Gethsemane - Church of All Nations and the ancient Olive Garden.
- Lunch. [Open buffet]
- Old City of Jerusalem via Lions' gate. Bethesda Pools - St Anne's, Chapel of Flagellation. Chapel of Condemnation, continuing Via Dolorosa to Calvary.
- Western Wall.
- Dome of the Rock. (View only)

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Day 07 — Abu Gosh, Mt Zion, Siloam Pools & Garden Tomb

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Transfer to Abu Gosh. (1 hour, requires check point crossing)
- Church of Notre Dame, site of the safe keeping of the Ar of the covenant.
- Trf to Jerusalem. (30 minutes)
- Mt. Zion. David's Tomb & Upper room.
- Walk to St. Peter in Gallicantu.
- Siloam pool and Hezekiah Tunnels.
- Lunch. (Buffet)
- Tour of Garden Tomb, widely accepted as the site of Jesus's crucifixion and resurrection.
- Communion at the Garden Tomb.
- Transfer to hotel in Bethlehem. (45 minutes)

Day 08 — Nebi Samuel, Qasr al Yahud, Jericho, Qumran & Dead Sea

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Transfer to Jerusalem. (1 hour, requires check point crossing)
- Prayer stop at Nebi Samuel.
- Qasr Al Yahud - The Baptism site at Jordan river. It is widely believed that Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist at this site on the eastern bank.
- Transfer to Jericho. Visit Sycamore tree & Zachaeus' house.
- Ascend Mt Temptation. [2 way cable car].
- Lunch. [Open buffet]
- Transfer to Qumran.
- Tour of Qumran caves, site of the discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls.
- Transfer to Dead Sea.
- Dead Sea, soak in the mineral rich waters and experience the Dead sea float.
- Transfer to hotel in Bethlehem. (1 hour 15 minutes, requires check point crossing)

- Transfer to Taba border with Egypt. (4 hours 30 minutes)
- Enter Egypt.
- Transfer to hotel in Taba. (30 minutes)
- Lunch. [Traditional buffet]
- Free time at Red Sea.

What are the travel requirements?

- Passport valid for at least 6 months from the start date of the tour.
- Entry permit as required for various Nationalities. Please refer [Egypt's visa policy](#); [Israel's visa policy](#); [Jordan's visa policy](#).
- Health insurance valid for the duration of the journey, preferably "cash free" policies.

Who can travel?

- Adult passengers from most countries.
- Minors must be accompanied by an immediate relative/guardian.

Is it safe to travel to Israel?

- It is safer than most places in the world.
- Stop watching the TV.

Are credit cards accepted in Jordan, Israel & Egypt?

- Yes, most credit cards are accepted in Jordan, Israel & Egypt.
- Please check with your service provider too.

Can an insurance policy be purchased in Jordan, Israel and Egypt?

- Yes, it could be done separately for each country; please write to us to know more.
- It will be cheaper and easier to purchase it from your country as a single policy.
- Always choose "cash free" policies.

Are foreign insurance policies accepted in Jordan, Israel & Egypt?

- Yes, they are, and it is preferred, because your insurance company is liable to the laws of your country, while local insurers are not.

Can cash be carried?

- Jordan:
- Cash could be carried, limited to JOD 10,000 which is about \$14,000 at an exchange rate of US\$ 1= JOD 0.7
- *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Jordanian law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*
- Israel:
- Cash could be carried, limited to NIS 12,000 which is about \$3250 at an exchange rate of US\$ 1= NIS 3.6.
- *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Israeli law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*
- Egypt:
- Cash could be carried, limited to US\$ 10,000.
- *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Egyptian law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*

How much does this package cost?
