Arriving to Tel Aviv, moving to Galilee and then to Jerusalem, the tour covers biblical Israel in 6 nights-7 days. From Israel to Jordan via Allenby bridge, the tour covers Mt Nebo, Dead Sea, Petra and Aqaba, spending one night at Dead Sea and one night at Petra. The tour takes a ferry to cross the Red Sea to arrive to Sinai Egypt. The Egypt leg of the tour covers St Catherine monastery, Old Cairo and the Giza Plateau, spending one night at the Red Sea coast in Sinai and 2 nights in Cairo.

- A 12 day Catholic pilgrimage from Israel to Egypt via Jordan.
- Accommodation plan: 3N Galilee, 3N Jerusalem, 1N Dead Sea, 1N Petra, 1N Sinai & 2N Cairo.
- This tour, starts in Israel, where biblical sites in the Galilee and Jerusalem are covered in a leisurely pace. [6 nights]
- It then enters Jordan transiting through Moab, Edom and Nabatea before crossing the Red Sea to enter Egypt. [2 nights]
- In Egypt the tour moves through the Sinai to Cairo, where the Giza Plateau and Old Cairo is covered. [3 nights]

Day 02 — Galilee churches, Boat ride, Magdala

Accommodation: Galilee

Meals Included: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

- Tour of the Galilee Churches:
- Mt of Beatitudes, the site of Jesus's sermon on the mount.
- Proceed to visit Capernaum (Kfar Nahum) the city of Jesus and the site of Jesus's ministry. The place of origin of healing and deliverance, the secrets of which were taught by Jesus.

- Visit Tabga, the site of the Jesus's miracle of the multiplication of bread loaves and fish to feed 5000 people.
- Short visit to Peter's house (Primacy of Peter).
- St Peter's fish lunch at the shores of the Sea of the Galilee.
- Tour of Magdala - Recently excavated archeological site of the first century city of Mary Magdalene.
- Visit the exquisite Boat Chapel complex, a marvel of modern architecture.
- Slow, short boat ride in the Galilee on a replica of ancient Galilean boats.
- Holy Mass at Mt Beatitudes or at the Boat Chapel, Magdala.

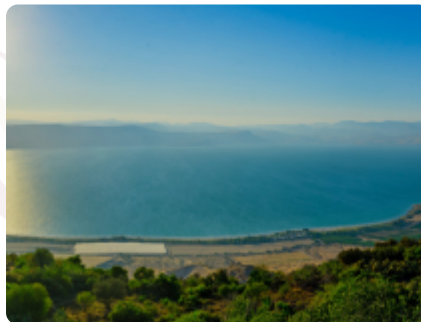

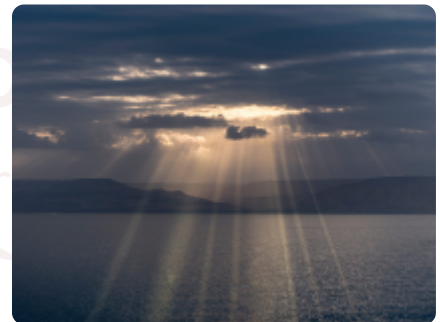

Day 03 — Mt Tabor, Cana, Nazareth

Accommodation: Galilee

Meals Included: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

- Transfer to the sanctuary of Tabor (30 minutes).
- Ride up the Tabor hill in a mini van to visit the magnificent Basilica of Transfiguration.
- Transfer to the village of Cana (20 minutes).
- Visit the Church of the wedding miracle.
- Transfer to Nazareth (30 mins).
- Buffet lunch at Nazareth.
- Tour of Nazareth Village - replica of a first century Nazarene village.

- Visit Basilica of Annunciation, Joseph's workshop & Jesus' synagogue.
- Lunch at Nazareth.
- Transfer to the hotel in Galilee (30 minutes).
- Holy Mass: Basilica of Transfiguration / Cana / Basilica of Annunciation.
- Option for renewal of wedding vows at Cana.

- Transfer to Haifa. (1 hour)
- View the magnificent Bahai Gardens and temple, considered as one of the modern wonders of Architecture.
- Tour of Elijah's Cave and Stella Marris Chapel.
- Transfer to Jaffa. (1 hour 30 minutes).
- Short tour of Old Jaffa visiting the site of Tbiatha's healing by St Peter.
- Lunch at Jaffa seafront.
- 13.30 Transfer to Ein Karem. (1 hour 15 minutes)
- Tour of the spectacular Basilica of Visitation.

- At the Visitations Basilica view the Magnificat in numerous languages on the walls.
- Church of John the Baptist.
- Transfer to hotel in Jerusalem.
- Holy Mass at Stella Marris Chapel, Mt Carmel or at Basilica of Visitations.

- Palm Sunday Road - view from below only, the steep decent being perilous.
- Visit the Basilica at Gethsemane - Church of All Nations and the ancient Olive Garden.
- Mt Zion- Upper room & David's Tomb.
- St Peter Gallicantu site of Peters denial of Jesus.
- Transfer to Bethlehem (30 minutes).
- Lunch. (Traditional Palestinian Barbecue)
- Shepherds' field.
- Basilica of Nativity & Manger Square.

- Transfer to the hotel in Jerusalem (30 minutes).
- Holy Mass at Gethsemane or at Basilica of Nativity.

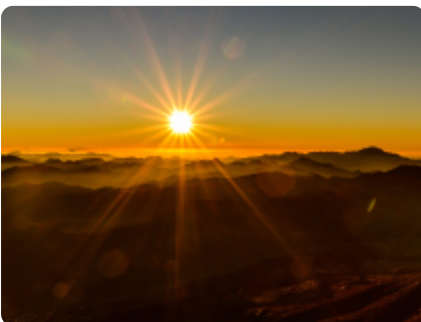

Petra is the legacy of the Nabataeans, an industrious Arab people who settled in southern Jordan more than 2,000 years ago. Admired then for its refined culture, massive architecture and ingenious complex of dams and water channels, Petra is a UNESCO World Heritages Site and one of the new Seven Wonders of the World. What are the travel requirements ?

- Passport valid for at least 6 months from the start date of the tour.
- Entry permit as required for various Nationalities. Please refer [Jordan's visa policy](#); [Israel's visa policy](#); [Egypt's visa policy](#).
- Health insurance valid for the duration of the journey, preferably "cash free" policies.

Who can travel?

- Adult passengers from most countries.
- Minors must be accompanied by an immediate relative/guardian.

Is it safe to travel to Israel?

- Israel is safer than most places in the world.
- Stop watching the TV.

Are credit cards accepted in Israel?

- Yes, most credit cards are accepted in Jordan, Israel & Egypt.
- Please check with your service provider too.

Can an insurance policy be purchased in Israel , Jordan & Egypt?

- Yes, it could be done separately for each country; please write to us to know more.
- It will be cheaper and easier to purchase it from your country as a single policy.

Are foreign insurance policies accepted in Israel, Jordan & Egypt?

- Yes, they are, and it is preferred, because your insurance company is liable to the laws of your country, while local insurers are not.

Can cash be carried?

- Israel:
 - Cash could be carried, limited to NIS 12,000 which is about \$3250 at an exchange rate of US\$ 1= NIS 3.6.
 - *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Israeli law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*
- Jordan:
 - Cash could be carried, limited to JOD 10,000 which is about \$14,000 at an exchange rate of US\$ 1= JOD 0.7
 - *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Jordanian law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*
- Egypt:
 - Cash could be carried, limited to US\$ 10,000.
 - *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Egyptian law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*
