- Onto Haifa and down the Mediterranean coast to Tel Aviv-Jaffa, culminating in Bethlehem. [4 nights]
- The tour then centers around Jerusalem visiting all major biblical sites including in parts of Samaria.
- The Egypt leg of the comprises of 3 nights with 1 night in Dahab by the Red Sea and 2 nights in Cairo. [3 nights]
- The final part of the tour visits St Catherine, Old Cairo and the Giza Plateau.

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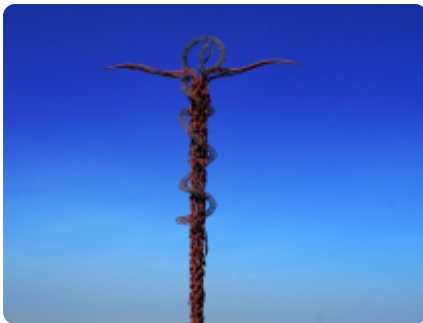

- Transfer to Galilee. (1 hour 45 minutes)
- Visit Kfar Nahum or Capernaum, the city of Jesus and the site of Jesus's ministry.
- Lunch. [St Peter's Fish lunch]
- Mt Beatitudes - site of Jesus's sermon on the mount.
- Tabga - site of the multiplication miracle.
- Peter's House & Mensa Christy.
- Boat Ride in the Sea of Galilee on a replica of ancient Galilean boats.

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

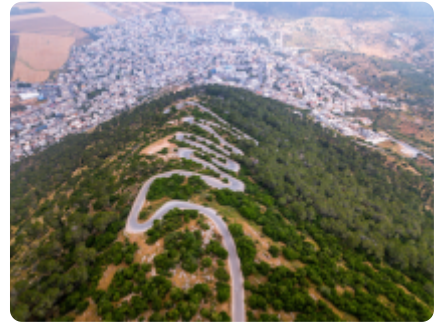
- Transfer to Mt Tabor base station. (30 minutes)

Day 05 — Haifa, Muharakha, Jaffa & Emmaus

- Transfer to Haifa. (1 hour)
- Mt Carmel. Visit Elijah's Cave at the Stella Marris chapel.
- View of Bahai Gardens and Temple.
- Transfer to Dalyat el Carmel. (45 minutes)
- Visit the Carmelite sanctuary of Muharakha. View of the Jezreel valley.
- Transfer to Jaffa (1 hour 30 minutes)
- St Peters Church, the site of the healing of Tabitha.
- Short tour of Jaffa.
- Lunch. *(Typical Mediterranean salads & seafood grill)*
- Transfer to Emmaus Nicopolis *[Sundays closed]*. (45 minutes)
- Visit the ancient ruins believed to be the biblical site of Emmaus.
- Transfer to the hotel in Bethlehem. (45 minutes)

Day 06 — Mt Olives, Gethsemane, Mt Zion & Bethlehem

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Transfer to Jerusalem. (1 hour, requires check point crossing)
- Tour of Mt Olives. View the iconic Dome of the Rock from Mt Olives.
- Short visit to the chapel of Ascension.
- Tour the sanctuary of Pater Noster where The Lord's Prayer is embedded in the walls in numerous languages.
- Palm Sunday Road - view from below only, the steep decent being perilous.
- Visit the Basilica at Gethsemane - Church of All Nations and the ancient Olive Garden.
- Mt. Zion. David's Tomb & Upper room.
- Walk to St. Peter in Gallicantu.
- Transfer to Bethlehem. (30 minutes)
- Lunch. [Traditional Palestinian / Open buffet]
- Shepherd's Field.
- Shopping for Religious Articles.
- Nativity Church & the grotto of Nativity.

Day 07 — Western Wall Tunnels, Via Dolorosa, Garden Tomb & Bethany

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Transfer to Jerusalem. (1 hour, requires check point crossing)
- Western Wall.
- Western wall Tunnels - proximity tour to the Holy of Holies.
- Dome of the Rock.
- Old City of Jerusalem via Lions' gate. Bethesda Pools - St Anne's, Chapel of Flagellation. Chapel of Condemnation, continuing Via Dolorosa to Calvary.
- Tour of Garden Tomb, widely accepted as the site of Jesus's crucifixion and resurrection.
- Communion at the Garden Tomb.
- Lunch. (Buffet)
- Transfer to Eizariya(Bethany). (25 minutes)
- Visit the Tomb of Lazarus and the house of Mary, Martha & Lazarus.
- Transfer to hotel in Bethlehem. (45 minutes)

Day 08 — Bet El, Tel Shiloh, Qasr al Yahud, Jericho & Dead Sea

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Fore noon tour of Samaria. 07.30 AM - Transfer to Bet El. (1 hour 30 minutes, requires check point crossing)
- Bet El -site of Jacob's dream of the ladder.
- Transfer to Tel Shiloh. (30 minutes)
- Detailed tour of Ancient Shiloh - site of Joshua's Tabernacles, which is believed to have stood here for 369 years.
- Transfer to Qasr al Yahud. (1 hour)
- Qasr Al Yahud - The Baptism site at Jordan river. It is widely believed that Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist at this site on the eastern bank.
- Transfer to Jericho. Visit Sycamore tree & Zachaeus' house.
- Ascend Mt Temptation. [2 way cable car].
- Lunch. [Open buffet]
- Transfer to Dead Sea.
- Dead Sea, soak in the mineral rich waters and experience the Dead sea float.
- Transfer to hotel in Bethlehem. (1 hour 15 minutes, requires check point crossing)

- Transfer to Taba border with Egypt. (4 hours 30 minutes)

"Set on the outskirts of old Nazareth, the Nazareth Village is built on ancient agricultural land that boasts the area's last remaining first-century wine press. The original farm has been restored with its ancient wine press, terraces, irrigation system and stone quarry, and exact replicas of first-century houses, a synagogue, a watchtower, mikveh and olive presses have been carefully constructed using the original building methods and materials."

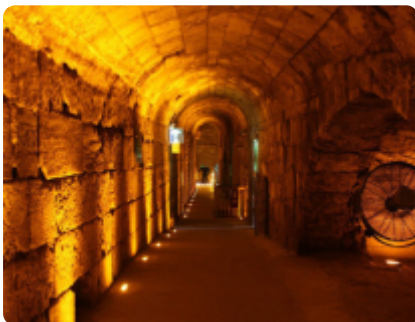
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Petra

The ancient city of Petra is one of Jordan's national treasures and by far its best known tourist attraction. Petra is the legacy of the Nabataeans, an industrious Arab people who settled in southern Jordan more than 2,000 years ago. Admired then for its refined culture, massive architecture and ingenious complex of dams and water channels, Petra is a UNESCO World Heritages Site and one of the new Seven Wonders of the World. Inhabited by the Nabateans, Edomites and Romans, Petra brought together the knowledge and skill of these civilizations to create this world wonder. Caravans laden with incense, silks, spices and other exotic goods would rest at Petra.

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The Western Wall Tunnel

"The excavation took over 20 years under very difficult conditions while archeological finds that can only be described as 'awesome' were uncovered. The Western Wall Heritage Foundation was assigned the task of continuing this project and bringing it to the world. With painstaking care, taking various religious, tourist, archeological, security and other considerations into account, and with Halachic (religious law) and scientific oversight, the Foundation continued with the excavation project, centimeter by centimeter, in order to uncover Jerusalem in all its former glory. Beautiful ornaments were found - archeological finds that were hugely important in understanding the city's history. And a "time tunnel" was created taking us back into Jerusalem's glory days."

Tour of Ancient Shiloh

This is the place where, starting from the time when Joshua Ben Nun led the Jewish People, the Tabernacle stood for 369 years; the place where the tribal inheritances were divided among the tribes. Here the Tu b'Av festival of love celebrations took place, and the tribes were reunited. Here is where Elkana came, "to worship and offer sacrifices to God in Shiloh," and this is where Hannah prayed for a son. Her prayer was answered. Samuel was born and Hannah brought him here, where he grew up to be a prophet and a leader. Shiloh was also the home of Ahiya the Shilonite, who prophesied to Jeroboam the son of Nebat, about the division of the kingdom of the House of David after King Solomon's reign, and about the exile of the Ten Tribes of Israel.

What are the travel requirements?

- Passport valid for at least 6 months from the start date of the tour.
- Entry permit as required for various Nationalities. Please refer [Egypt's visa policy](#); [Israel's visa policy](#); [Jordan's visa policy](#).
- Health insurance valid for the duration of the journey, preferably "cash free" policies.

Who can travel?

- Adult passengers from most countries.
- Minors must be accompanied by an immediate relative/guardian.

Is it safe to travel to Israel?

- It is safer than most places in the world.
- Stop watching the TV.

Are credit cards accepted in Jordan, Israel & Egypt?

- Yes, most credit cards are accepted in Jordan, Israel & Egypt.
- Please check with your service provider too.

Can an insurance policy be purchased in Jordan, Israel and Egypt?

- Yes, it could be done separately for each country; please write to us to know more.
- It will be cheaper and easier to purchase it from your country as a single policy.
- Always choose "cash free" policies.

Are foreign insurance policies accepted in Jordan, Israel & Egypt?

- Yes, they are, and it is preferred, because your insurance company is liable to the laws of your country, while local insurers are not.

Can cash be carried?

- Jordan:
 - Cash could be carried, limited to JOD 10,000 which is about \$14,000 at an exchange rate of US\$ 1= JOD 0.7
 - *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Jordanian law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*
- Israel:
 - Cash could be carried, limited to NIS 12,000 which is about \$3250 at an exchange rate of US\$ 1= NIS 3.6.
 - *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Israeli law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*
- Egypt:
 - Cash could be carried, limited to US\$ 10,000.
 - *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Egyptian law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*
