Pilgrimage | Church Groups

- One week of Biblical experience in Israel.
- Entering Israel from the Jordan river border crossing, the tour traverses major biblical sites in the Galilee.[2 nights]
- Onto Haifa and down the Mediterranean coast to Tel Aviv-Jaffa, culminating in Bethlehem.[4nights]
- The tour continues to visit all of Jerusalem, Kiryat Yearim, Ein Karem, Bet El, Jericho, Bethlehem, Bethany & Dead Sea.
- High Value Tours included: Nazareth Village, Mt Temptation & City of David

Cutomised program

Day wise program structure. Transfer times less than 20 minutes are not mentioned.

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Day 01 — Galilee Churches, St Peters fish lunch & Boat Ride

Accommodation: Tiberias

Meals Included: Lunch & Dinner

- 10.30 Enter Israel from Jordan through the Jordan river border crossing (Sheikh Hussein Bridge).
- Transfer to Galilee. (1 hour 45 minutes)
- Visit Kfar Nahum or Capernaum, the city of Jesus and the site of Jesus's ministry.
- Lunch. [St Peter's Fish lunch]
- Mt Beatitudes - site of Jesus's sermon on the mount.
- Tabga - site of the multiplication miracle.
- Peter's House & Mensa Christi.
- Boat Ride in the Sea of Galilee on a replica of ancient Galilean boats.

Day 02 — Mt Tabor, Nazareth, Nazareth Village & Cana

Accommodation: Tiberias

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Transfer to Mt Tabor base station. (30 minutes)
- Drive up the Tabor hill in a mini van to visit the Basilica of Transfiguration.
- Transfer to Nazareth. (30 minutes)

- Nazareth - Church of the Annunciation & Josef's workshop.
- Tour of Nazareth Village.
- Lunch. [Biblical lunch at Nazareth Village]
- Transfer to Cana. (30 minutes)
- Cana - Church of the wedding miracle.
- Transfer to hotel in Tiberias. (30 minutes)

Day 03 — Haifa, Muhrakha, Ceasarea, Jaffa & Bethlehem

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- 7.00 AM - Transfer to Haifa. (1 hour)
- Mt Carmel. Visit Elijah's Cave at the Stella Marris chapel.
- View of Bahai Gardens and Temple.
- Transfer to Dalyat el Carmel. (45 minutes)
- Visit the Carmelite sanctuary of Muhrakha. View of the Jezreel valley.
- Transfer to Cesarea. (45 minutes)
- Brief stop to view Mediterranean Sea & Roman aqueduct
- Transfer to Jaffa via Tel Aviv beachfront(1 hour)

- St Peters Church, the site of the healing of Tabitha.
- Transfer to Bethlehem. (1 hour 30 minutes)
- Lunch. [Traditional Palestinian / Open buffet]
- Shepherd's Field.
- Shopping for Religious Articles.
- Nativity Church & the grotto of Nativity.

Day 04 — Bethany, Bet El, Qasr al Yahud, Jericho & Dead Sea

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Transfer to Eizariya(Bethany). (45 minutes) *[Depends upon the existing security conditions]*
- Visit the Tomb of Lazarus and the house of Mary, Martha & Lazarus.
- Transfer to Bet El via Hizma. (45 minutes)
- Transfer to Qasr al Yahud via Shiloh(outside view). (1 hour 30 minutes)
- Qasr Al Yahud - The Baptism site at Jordan river. It is widely believed that Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist at this site on the eastern bank.
- Transfer to Jericho. Visit Sycamore tree & Zachaeus' house.
- Lunch. [Open buffet]
- Transfer to Dead Sea.
- Dead Sea, soak in the mineral rich waters and experience the Dead sea float.

- Transfer to hotel in Bethlehem. (1 hour 15 minutes, requires check point crossing)

Day 05 — Garden Tomb, Old City, Mt Olives & Gethsemane

Accommodation: Bethlehem

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- Transfer to Jerusalem. (1 hour, requires check point crossing)
- Tour of Garden Tomb, widely accepted as the site of Jesus's crucifixion and resurrection.
- Communion at the Garden Tomb.
- Old City of Jerusalem via Lions' gate. Bethesda Pools - St Anne's, Chapel of Flagellation. Chapel of Condemnation, continuing Via Dolorosa to Calvary.
- Lunch. (Buffet)
- Tour of Mt Olives. View the iconic Dome of the Rock from Mt Olives.
- Short visit to the chapel of Ascension.
- Tour the sanctuary of Pater Noster where The Lord's Prayer is embedded in the walls in numerous languages.
- Palm Sunday Road - view from below only, the steep decent being perilous.
- Visit the Basilica at Gethsemane - Church of All Nations and the ancient Olive Garden.
- Transfer to hotel in Bethlehem.

- Transfer to Jerusalem. (1 hour, requires check point crossing)
- Western Wall.
- Dome of the Rock.
- Mt. Zion. David's Tomb & Upper room.
- Walk to St. Peter in Gallicantu.
- Tour of Siloam Pools, Hezekiel Tunnels and City of David
- Lunch. [Buffet]
- Transfer to Ein Karem. (20 minutes)
- Visit the Church of John the Baptist.
- Transfer to hotel in Bethlehem. (30 minutes)

The original farm has been restored with its ancient wine press, terraces, irrigation system and stone quarry, and exact replicas of first-century houses, a synagogue, a watchtower, mikveh and olive presses have been carefully constructed using the original building methods and materials."

"In this guided tour, you will walk in the footsteps of the kings and prophets, through underground passageways and in the waters of the Siloam tunnel (Hezekiah's tunnel) by flashlight. Join a magical and mysterious journey among ancient shafts, walls and fortifications of the City of David – the place where it all began. As part of the tour, you will visit the spring presentation – where you can feel the story of the Shiloach tunnel in an exciting 3D display that will draw you into the past, just before entering the water system. For those walking in the wet route – bring suitable shoes for walking in water and a change of clothes."

What are the travel requirements?

- Passport valid for at least 6 months from the start date of the tour.
- Entry permit as required for various Nationalities. [Egypt's visa policy](#). [Israel's visa policy](#). [Jordan's visa policy](#).
- Health insurance valid for the duration of the journey, preferably "cash free" policies.

Who can travel?

- Adult passengers from most countries.
- Minors must be accompanied by an immediate relative/guardian.

Is it safe to travel to Israel?

- Israel is safer than most places in the world.
- Stop watching the TV.

Are credit cards accepted in Israel?

- Yes, all credit cards are accepted in Israel.
- Please check with your service provider too.

Can an insurance policy be purchased in Israel?

- Yes, please write to us to know more.

Are foreign insurance policies accepted in Israel?

- Yes, they are, and it is preferred, because your insurance company is liable to the laws of your country, while local Israeli insurers are not.

Can cash be carried?

- Cash could be carried, but currently it is limited to NIS 12,000 which is about \$3250 at an exchange rate of US\$ 1= NIS 3.6.
- *Passengers carrying currencies whose total value exceeds the above amount are required by Israeli law to make a declaration with the customs at the port of entry.*

How much does this package cost?
